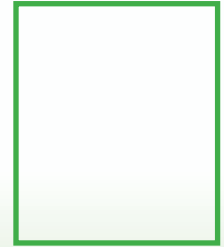

Guest speaker **Cynthia Morton** is a botanist and independent researcher and has worked on a wide variety of projects, including investigating park and nursery tree genetics. She is just finishing conducting studies on local red maples and hollies with Phil Gruszka, Director of Horticulture and Forestry, Pittsburgh Parks Conservancy.

Cynthia holds an M.S. in biology from the University of North Carolina and a Ph.D. in biology from CUNY/New York Botanical Garden and currently teaches at Chatham University in Pittsburgh, PA. Join us.
