<b>FLOWERS</b>				
Anise Hyssop	<i>Agastache foeniculum</i>	Full sun to part shade. 2-4' H x 1.5-3' W. Tough, mounding perennial with long-lasting, showy purple flowers in late summer to fall. Good drainage is essential (no clay).	\$25.00	5 plants per strip
Wild Columbine	<i>Aquilegia canadensis</i>	Full sun to part shade; medium moisture. 2' H x 1' W. Delicate red and yellow flowers rise above basal leaves in April-June. Harbinger of spring!	\$22.00	4 plants per strip
Swamp Milkweed	<i>Asclepias incarnata</i>	Full sun to part sun. Grows to 3-4' H x 2' W. Upright clumping plant with showy pink flowers in June and July. Lance-shaped foliage grows to 4-5" long. Prefers steady moisture but can tolerate well-drained soils and inundation.	\$27.50	5 plants per strip
Butterfly Weed	<i>Asclepias tuberosa</i>	Full sun. 1.5-2' H x 2-3' W. Flat-topped 2-3" clusters of bright-orange flowers. Prefers dry to medium soils. Tolerates inundation.	\$27.50	5 plants per strip
Longflower Alumroot	<i>Heuchera longiflora</i>	Full shade to part sun. Basal foliage to 4" H x 12" W with flowers to 1' H. Deep green basal foliage with silver highlights, and creamy-yellow fuzzy flowers in May-June. Needs consistent moisture.	\$25.00	4 plants per strip
Meehan's Mint	<i>Meehania cordata</i>	Full or part shade groundcover. 2" H foliage on runners with pale purple flowers to 6" H in late spring. Dry or moist shade. A well-behaved mint!	\$22.00	4 plants per strip
Spotted beebalm	<i>Monarda punctata</i>	Full sun to part shade. Prefers dry to average, well-drained soils. Grows 2-3' H x 2' W. Pink bracts with creamy white flowers with purple spots in July-Aug.	\$25.00	5 plants per strip
Sundrops	<i>Oenothera fruticosa</i>	Full sun to light shade. Grows to 1.5-2' H x 3' W. Sprawling, clumping plant bears cheerful yellow butter-cup shaped flowers in May and June, then again in mid-summer after cut-back. Likes light, sandy soil.	\$27.50	5 plants per strip
Roundleaf ragwort	<i>Packera obovata</i>	Full shade to part sun. 4" H basal foliage x 12-18" H flowers x 18" W and spreading by runners. Sunny yellow flowers in May-June ripen to white puffs of seed as summer progresses. Shear off vertical growth after bloom or seeding to maintain groundcover look.	\$25.00	4 plants per strip
White Beardtongue	<i>Penstemon digitalis</i>	Full sun. Prefers dry to medium soils. Grows to 2-4' H x 18" W. Clusters of tubular 1" white flowers arise April-June from deep green basal leaf rosettes.	\$25.00	5 plants per strip
Jacob's Ladder	<i>Polemonium reptans</i>	Part to full shade. 1-1.5' H x 2' W. Compound leaves give this plant its "ladder" name. Pale blue-purple flowers in spring. Prefers rich, medium-moisture soils.	\$22.00	4 plants per strip
Black-eyed Susan	<i>Rudbeckia fulgida</i> var. <i>fulgida</i>	Full sun. Grows to 1-3' H and 18-24" W. Coneflower with yellow-orange petals with a black center, creating a 2-3" flower head. Likes dry to medium moisture but can tolerate inundation.	\$25.00	5 plants per strip
Wild Petunia	<i>Ruellia humilis</i>	Full sun to part shade. Grows to 2' H x 12" W. Low-growing bright green foliage and bluish-lavender flowers through summer and into fall. Can spread vigorously by seed.	\$25.00	5 plants per strip
Bluestem Goldenrod	<i>Solidago caesia</i>	Full shade to part sun. Grows 2-3' H x 18" W. Non-invasive goldenrod with arching gold clusters in September over blue-green foliage. Prefers moist, well drained soils but tolerates drought, dry and poor soils once established.	\$25.00	5 plants per strip

Foamflower	<i>Tiarella cordifolia</i>	Full shade to part sun. 1-2' H x 1' W. White flowers in late spring-early summer over heart-shaped attractive foliage clumps. Prefers moist soils but can tolerate medium.	\$25.00	4 plants per strip
<b>FERNS, GRASSES and SEDGES</b>				
Lady Fern	<i>Athyrium filix-femina</i>	Full shade to part sun, but prefers bright shade. Grows to 2-3' H x 2.5' W. Feathery/lacy fern in erect form, with new foliage throughout the summer. Prefers rich, moist soils.	\$25.00	4 plants per strip
Creek Sedge	<i>Carex amphibola</i>	Full sun to full shade. 12" H x 12" W. Fountain-shaped 1/8" wide foliage that's a great groundcover or edging. Prefers moist or medium soils.	\$22.00	4 plants per strip
Pennsylvania Sedge	<i>Carex pennsylvanica</i>	Full to part shade. Grows to 8-10" H x 1-1.5' W, with a graceful, floppy habit. Fine-textured leaves stay green all winter. Prefers light shade and medium moisture. Slow-spreading.	\$25.00	4 plants per strip
Purple Love Grass	<i>Eragrostis spectabilis</i>	Full sun. Likes infertile, well-drained soils. Does not perform in rich, moist soils. 18-24" H x 2' W. Bronze-red soft, fluffy clouds of inflorescenc in late summer-early fall. Light green leaves in summer turn golden in fall.	\$22.00	5 plants per strip
<b>VINES AND WOODIES</b>				
Blue False Indigo	<i>Baptisia australis</i>	Full to part sun. Grows to 3-4' H x 3-4' W, creating a shrub-like appearance at maturity. Bluish-green foliage with tall spikes of blue flowers in May, ripening to showy black seedpods. Tolerates a range of soils and conditions, but does not transplant well as mature plant, so site carefully.	\$7.00	Single plant
Old Man's Beard	<i>Clematis virginiana</i>	Full sun to full shade. Vigorous twining vine with fragrant 1-inch white flowers beginning in late summer, early fall. Prefers average to moist soils. Spent flowers leave seed heads with a curly, lacy form, reminiscent of a white beard.	\$7.00	Single plant
